



What the students are learning in

English	Group 1 (7,8) - In English, students will be exploring the theme of conflict through a range of texts. This includes several poems and extracts from various novels. Students will have the opportunity to respond to the texts and creatively write their own. Group 2 - In English, students will be exploring the theme of leisure and holidays through a range of texts. This includes several poems and extracts from various novels. Students will have the opportunity to respond to the texts and creatively write their own.
Maths	Group 1 (7,8) - In Mathematics, students will begin by exploring number and the properties of number. This includes number place value, reading and writing numbers, ordering numbers, odd and even numbers and number sequences. Group 2 (9, 10, 11) – Students will begin by exploring number and the properties of number. This includes number place value, reading and writing numbers, ordering numbers, odd and even numbers and number sequences, negative numbers, significant figures, and decimal places.
Science	Group 1 (7,8) - Students will begin their journey in science by learning how to work safely in the laboratory and developing their investigative skills. They will then move onto learning about the particle model of matter and how to use this and apply it to separating substances. Group 2 (9, 10, 11) – Students will be starting the entry level certificate in science and will complete the Biology 1 component, The Human Body. This will investigate how the human body is composed and how we carry out vital life processes.
Computer Science	In Computer Science, students will learn how to use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly; recognise acceptable/unacceptable behaviour; identify a range of ways to report concerns about content and how to stay safe online
History	Group 1 (7,8) - Students will be learning all about how migration has changed Britain Group 2 (9, 10, 11) – Students will be learning about a historical change over time – medicine through the ages
Religious Studies	Group 1 (7,8) - Students will learn about Founders and leaders Group 2 (9, 10, 11) – Students will study Contentious Issues, including different relationships
Geography	Group 1 (7,8) - Students will be learning about the geography of our local area Group 2 (9, 10, 11) – Students will study changes in UK population
Life skills/ ASDAN	Students will be learning about important healthy choices and living a healthy lifestyle.
Food Technology	Students will begin learning about food from around the world, having a practical lesson once a fortnight
Art	In art, students will be learning about the 7 formal elements of art
Drama	Workshop based activities to develop speaking, listening, communication and social skills. Students will also be introduced to some key drama skills including freeze frames and thought tracks.
Music	Introduction to music and piano skills. Pupils will learn basic piano skills and learn a piece of music on the keyboard.
P.E	Students will be developing and demonstrating skills in communication and teamwork through Football and Netball. Students will also have one session per fortnight from the Warrington Wolves Foundation.
MFL	Group 1 (7,8) - Students are learning how to give their opinions of different school subjects, using the skills of Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing Group 2 (9, 10, 11) – Students will study social issues, including the environment, the weather and health
